“Do”	<i>says</i>	“Done”
Man does	<i>emphasizes what</i>	God does
Flesh (self-life)	<i>lives out of the</i>	Spirit (Christ-life)
Man’s Resources	<i>draws upon</i>	God’s Resources
External Rules, Regulations, Standards	<i>deals with</i>	Internal Heart Attitude
Ought To’s, Should’s, Have To’s, Must’s	<i>primary focus is on</i>	Want To’s
Bondage, Duty, Obligation	<i>creates</i>	Freedom
Outside - in	<i>lives life from the</i>	Inside - out
“Do ... in order to be” (performance-based)	<i>declares</i>	“You are ... therefore, do” (identity-based)
Guilt, Condemnation	<i>produces</i>	Acceptance, Security
Defeat	<i>leads to</i>	Victory
